RE: Influenza (Flu) and Influenza-like Illness (ILI) Procedures UPDATED

- Head Start programs and Day Care are closed this week through Friday, Nov 6th due to influenza and influenza-like illness (ILI). Programs will re-open Monday, Nov 9th.
- Anyone having flu symptoms should call the clinic to report their symptoms or symptoms of family members
- H1N1 (swine flu) vaccine is available at the clinic for these high risk individuals
 - Pregnant women
 - People living with or providing care to infants UNDER 6 months old
 - Healthcare, EMS or Head Start personnel
 - Children 6 months old to 24 years of age
 - **People aged 25 through 64 years of age with certain high risk medical conditions**
- Seasonal flu vaccine is available at the clinic. If you have not yet received your regular flu shot, please call the clinic to make an appointment.
- People with flu and flu-like symptoms should be encouraged to isolate themselves to prevent the spread of illness.
