CONFEDERATED TRIBES OF THE CHEHALIS RESERVATION
DRAFT TRIBAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the 2012 updated Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP) for the Confederated Tribes of the Chehalis Reservation is available for public review. A 30-day public review period will begin on January 13th and close on February 14th, 2012.

The Confederated Tribes of the Chehalis Reservation has identified the following carry-over projects from previous year's TIPS as the priorities for the years from 2012-2015:

1. Howanut Realignment Project (IRR Route 0026 Section 5, 10, 15)
2. Secena Road Design & Construction (IRR Route 13 Section 5)
3. Hwy 12 Safety Improvements (IRR Route 28 Section 65, 70)
4. South Anderson Road Widening and Sidewalks
5. SR 12 - Black River Bridge (IRR Route 0028 Section 95)
6. South Bank Road Culverts at Sickman Ford Bridge
7. Public Transportation

In addition to these carry over projects, a new project is proposed:

8. Reservation wide Residential Traffic Calming

These projects are consistent with the Tribe's 2010 Long Range Transportation Plan which is updated at least every 5 years.

Transportation funds received by the Tribe during years 2012-2014 will be directed to the above projects. A copy of the draft TTIP is available in the Planning Department at the Chehalis Tribal Center located at 420 Howanut Rd., Oakville, WA.
