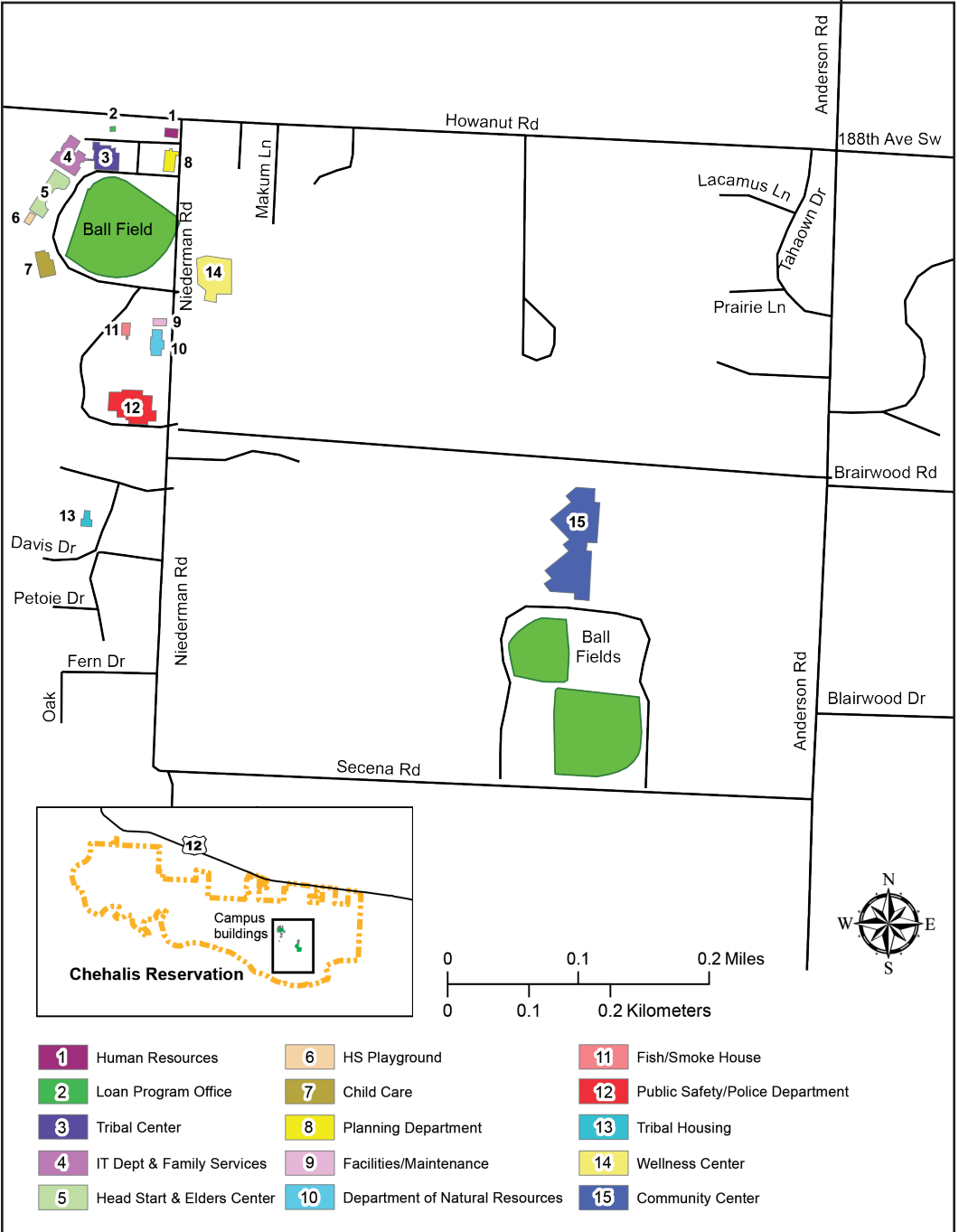

- Events staff host community holiday events such as Christmas and Halloween festivities and help organize the annual Chehalis Tribal Days.

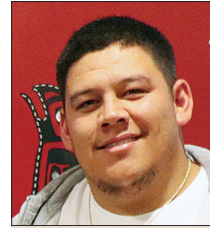

Tribe pulls together to complete sacred Canoe Journey

The Chehalis Tribal Canoe Family returned to the waterways to take part in the 2023 intertribal Canoe Journey Paddle to Mackleshoob. The theme of this year's voyage was Honoring Our Warriors Past and Present.

Tulzap in the name of the Chehalis Tribe's 25-foot vessel that the canoe family takes on the annual journey. The Chehalis people joined this year's voyage on July 24 in Lacey, Elahsa near Port Angeles. This was a main pit stop for dozens of canoe families from the Pacific Coast and British Columbia, Canada.
