

What: Trends in Opioid Misuse and Abuse

Rates of prescription opioid medication misuse remain high but have leveled in comparison to a sharp increase in the use of heroin. This program is intended to illustrate recent trends in both prescription and illicit opioid use, as well as discuss pharmacology and physical effects. Consequences to public health continue to emerge and require approaches to mitigate the risks associated with opioid misuse, abuse, and addiction.



Kelly Olson is the Associate Director of Clinical Affairs at Millennium Health. She is an experienced researcher in molecular neuro-pharmacology, as well as in clinical biology in the areas of mental illness, sleep, adrenal fatigue, and addictions.
