

# HATCHERY BRIDGE LANE CLOSURE

EFFECTIVE DATE:  
NOVEMBER 9, 2020



## The Situation:

The Planning Department has worked closely with the Highway Engineers at the Bureau of Indian Affairs as well as a private Engineering firm regarding the Hatchery Bridge. It has been determined that the guardrail can no longer be attached to the North side of the bridge due to continual damage.

The decision has been made to close the Westbound lane until the Hatchery Bridge can be replaced.

## The Solution:

A number of highly visible barricades will be added to the Westbound lane, closing the lane and guiding traffic. There will be warning signs in both directions of the upcoming change in the roadway as well as additional pavement markings on the road to assist traffic.

This temporary lane closure will be in place until the Hatchery Bridge is replaced. The replacement of the bridge is anticipated to take place in the summer of 2021.

We understand that this is an inconvenience to the community, but is the only approach available to address the unsafe situation on the Hatchery Bridge.
