The Chehalis Tribe seeks proposals for commissioned Native artwork for the two water towers from Chehalis Tribal Members only.

#### Designs should have;

- ⇒ a graphic approach,
- ⇒ No blending due to industrial paints not being able to blend
- **Southernly View of water towers** ⇒ The design should be simple with larger shapes so it is readable
  - ⇒ Limit to 8-10 colors max
  - ⇒ Each Water Tank to have a specific or cohesive design
  - ⇒ Identify the design for Tank A and for Tank B

The artist or artists selected will work with Artists Brothers to incorporate their design/s and have painted by Artists Brothers on our water towers.

The towers are each 100 feet in height, the smaller tower has a diameter of 14' (tank A) and the larger tower has a diameter of 35' (tank B)

There is multiple viewpoints to the water towers so this must be kept in mind while design the art


To apply please submit the following:

- One to two page proposal describing the design concept including dimensions and colors for each tank
- Artist fee for the artwork including time, materials and supplies
- Portfolio that includes at least 3-5 examples of previous work by the artist

Submission deadline for proposals due: June 9th, 2023

Selected artists will enter into a contract with the Chehalis Tribe. Final artwork must be completed by **June 23rd**, **2023**. Final artwork will be owned by the Chehalis Tribe.
