The Chehalis Tribe's Work Force Development, WFD, program is designed to provide intensive case management employment and training and related services to help individuals. It supports people that are working or in school, ages 6 to 75. Chehalis WFD program Service area is the Chehalis reservation, Grays Harbor, Lewis and Thurston counties.

- Identify and resolve barriers to employment.
- Further your education.
- Receive vocational training.
- Gain work experience.
- Obtain and/or retain full-time paid employment.
- Advance in the workforce.
- Make a steady forward movement to achieve unsubsidized employment; and
- Build stronger, more resilient, more equitable economies through entrepreneurship.

Chehalis Tribe's WFD goals are:

- Integrate employment, education, training, childcare, and related services to improve the effectiveness of those services.
- Provide education and employment training, and related services to eligible community members that will lead to self-sufficiency.
- Operate a "one-stop" center that provides an ease of service to clients in need of employment, education, training, and related services that supports them on their chosen paths to self-sufficiency.
