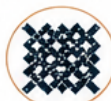

- Take pictures of products for inventory tracking (in class if needed)
- Organize and prepare inventory
- Get everything ready to qualify for the \$100 purchase

The \$100 will not be provided until the inventory sheet is complete and the products have been received and verified by us.

WHEN PRODUCTS SELL

100% of the artist's requested sale price goes back to you.

After the showcase, we will reconcile sales and pay you for items sold. Unsold items may remain on display at our office and continue to be offered for sale. You receive the proceeds when they sell.
