- Have higher PSA levels when diagnosed
- Have more aggressive tumors
- Experience higher cancer death rates than many other groups

EARLY DETECTION SAVES LIVES!

PSA (Prostate-Specific Antigen) tests are simple blood tests that check the health of your prostate
