## **Notice for Opportunity for Public Comments**

Pollution to rivers and streams comes from many sources and can be many different types. Pollution that is not from one direct place (like a pipe) is referred to as “Non-Point Source” and is a more common contributor to potential problems than many people realize.

The Chehalis Tribe Department of Natural Resources (DNR) in cooperation with the US EPA has completed an assessment and management plan related to non-point source pollution contributions into the rivers, streams and lakes upstream of the Chehalis Tribe Reservation. This assessment and management plan enables the DNR to utilize federal funding to help combat pollution issues from these non-point source contributions.

The community is invited to review and comment on both the assessment and management plan which can be found on the Tribe website.
